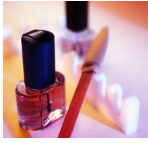




2010 OUTREACH EVENTS

Rather than giving away presents, the Christmas store restores dignity by allowing parents to purchase gifts and provide for their family. If parents are unable to pay for their presents, they help run the store to earn money.
